- All booths must have an interactive game or activity. This is what makes the Palooza different - it doesn't have to be complex or expensive, just make it fun!
- No solicitations allowed. Collection of contact information from interested parties is OK.
- Reid Park does not allow balloons, water balloons, water guns, live animals, etc.
- Please bring your own table/chairs/weights. Tents must be weighted down, not staked, **no exceptions**. If you do not have a way to secure your tent, you will be required to remove it. Maximum tent size allowed is 10' x 10'.
- We do not have access to electricity.
